Fancy a go at Petanque – or you may know this fascinating game as boules. Nottingham City petanque Club are hosting a session of petanque for us.

You do not need to have played before – all will be explained – and it is very easy to get going and just start playing. The club will provide the necessary equipment. Dress for the weather, but open-toed shoes are not a good idea – boules are heavy if you drop one on your foot!

The charge for this session, which lasts for about two hours, is £3 per person, which includes some refreshments – payable on the day.

The club is situated on Valley Road, in front of the City Hospital, and next to the tennis courts you can see from the Ring Road. The car park entrance is off the roundabout with Edwards Lane, opposite the former Five Ways pub. At the moment the car park is getting very busy with parking for the adjacent hospital, so car sharing is a good option.
