

Stoke Bardolph Walk
Wednesday 28th September

The walk on Wednesday 28th September will start at the Ferry Boat Inn, Stoke Bardolph (NG14 5HX) and is around 4.25 miles in length. It will include an amble alongside the Trent and around Netherfield Lagoons before returning to the Ferry Boat for lunch.

The walk is on good paths and is almost all flat apart from one short, steepish bank. There are a couple of easy stiles. It does tend to get very muddy if we have prolonged rain (at the moment you can almost fall through the cracks in the dry earth and fetch up in Australia!)

There is a public car park just before the pub on the right hand side of the road. However, the Ferry Boat are happy for us to use their very large car park as we will be having lunch there.

The pub is open from 09.00hrs if you fancy a coffee (or even breakfast) before the walk - and of course, to use the 'facilities'. If needed there are some opportunities for a loo break in the woods at around the 1 mile point.

I would suggest that we meet from 10.00hrs ready to start the walk at 10.30. I'll book tables for us for lunch at 12.15/12.30ish.
